March 25 – Lori Shato from the Lending Cupboard attended the meeting and gave us a rundown of what the Lending Cupboard does for the community and how donations are put to good use. Since 2006 the lending cupboard has been helping Central Albertans with their medical needs, lending up to 15000 pieces of medical equipment. Since moving to their new location on the north end of Red Deer, they can now do a complete flow through of equipment, from items being returned at the back of the building, to cleaning and preparing them to be moved to the front of the building, out the front door and into peoples' homes.

Also, at this meeting there was a lot of information sharing for the group. Below is a short description of the happenings for April.
